Gender Equality means that access to rights or opportunities should be unaffected by gender. The empowerment of women and girls in all areas of life is very important. Reducing humanitarian need means anticipating and responding to crises such as natural disasters, conflict and food shortages, to protect the most vulnerable and those most at risk. Climate action means acting to combat climate change and helping vulnerable people to adapt to climate change.

Strengthening governance means strengthening the way that organizations or countries are managed. Helping to build legal systems and protecting human rights are an important element of this.
